After the excitements of 1974 with the first meeting of the IAMLANZ in New Zealand and the formation of our own Division, and the June issue of Continuo full of New Zealand affairs, there seems little to report for this newsletter. Professor Gerald Seaman, Chairman of the N.Z. Division and convener of our Annual General Meeting on February 10, 1975 in Auckland, has promised us a most interesting day, and doubtless there will be plenty of news for the June issue. It would be wonderful if some Australians were to appear on the scene - who knows? Please consider yourselves cordially invited.

There have been things happening on the music scene, though, which are bound to have their effect on libraries. A new school for instrumentalists will commence at the Wellington Polytechnic in February 1975, which means that Wellington will be able to offer three schools for the training of young musicians - the Executant Diploma courses at the University, the select group of orchestral trainees trained each year by Ashley Heenan (this scheme was commenced in the early 1960's by John Hopkins and has been so successful that the group now tours overseas), and this new one. More instrumentalists mean more concerts mean more listeners mean more demands on music in libraries.

Wilfred Simenaur, for several years first cellist in the Sydney Symphony Orchestra and now co-leader of the N.Z. Broadcasting Corporation Symphony Orchestra is working on a scheme for helping country people to attend symphony concerts, and this has been receiving wide newspaper publicity. He proposes the formation of N.Z.B.C. Symphony Supporters Clubs outside the central city areas. People living within a radius of three hours travelling from any of the many cities to which the orchestra regularly travels would be encouraged to attend concerts by means of travel concessions, preferential booking privileges, unusual commencement times for concerts (to enable the traveller to return home that night), specially designed programmes with illustrations and demonstrations where appropriate, wine and cheese parties after concerts where club patrons could discuss the music with members of the orchestra, concerts of smaller groups making special visits to country areas, and so on. This scheme fits in well with the current climate for encouraging regional development, and there is no doubt that if it succeeds there will be renewed interest in the collections of music and records at local public libraries and available through interloan. More demand makes for better collections, and this is one of our Society's main objects in New Zealand.

Our short library history indicates that a generous bequest of music scores or money for music to a public library encourages it to begin building on this if it has possessed no music, and aim for a richer collection if it has. The best example of this is Auckland Public Library's excellent collection of scores and service to users (both probably unsurpassed in the country) which was encouraged by a generous bequest of money by William Townsend in 1947. It was pleasant, therefore, to see press publicity given recently to the donation of \$150 to Wellington Public Library by the Wellington Society of Music Teachers for the purchase of scores by Stravinsky.

Press publicity has also been given to Alexander Turnbull Library's drive for collecting scores, records, letters and documents, old programmes, etc. relevant to the work of New Zealand composers and musicians. The Librarian is pleased with the response so far, and arrangements are being made to transfer many of the manuscript scores from the N.Z.B.C. Music Library to this branch of the National Library of New Zealand. A Special Materials Librarian will commence work there early in 1975 and music will be one of her responsibilities.
